We have members who regularly give their time to organizations such as the [Oregon Food Bank](#), [Northwest Children's Outreach](#), [Community Action](#) and [Sonrise Church's Shelters](#), [Tuesdays' Treasures](#) monthly fellowship for adults with Developmental Disabilities, [Habitat for Humanity](#) and [Tuality Hospital](#). HPC supports the [Village Of Hope Uganda](#) and our very own Becky Smith's work there.

HPC gives 10% of undesignated income to the missions such as 4 Presbytery special offerings, Habitat for Humanity, [Village of Hope Uganda](#), [SIM](#), [Quiet Waters Outreach](#), [Salvation Army](#), [Medical Teams International](#) and [ARMS](#). Annual fundraisers include school supply collections in September for local schools in need, an October Craft Fair for Village of Hope Uganda, and the Three Tables of Christmas Joy where toys, food and money are collected for local children and the Oregon Food Bank.
